FS/ EAP Identifying Apparel

(Now including Searchers)

DSSI would like to notify you about a change regarding when FS/ EAP Staff should don their identifying apparel. 3 RCNY 404-01 and 404-02 state the following regarding identification:

Upon implementation of the Fire Safety Plan, Emergency Action Plan or during FS/ EAP drills, the Fire Safety/EAP Director and all FS/ EAP Staff shall identify themselves to building occupants and others by donning a vest, armband or other form of identification indicating their role.

* Please note that 3 RCNY 404-01 and 404-02 now requires FS/ EAP Staff to identify themselves during any FS or EAP Drills.

As we start another year of providing FS/ EAP Warden/ Deputy Warden and Searchers training, DSSI recommends that each building maintain an inventory of identifying apparel that can be issued to any NEW members of the FS/ EAP Warden team. As stated in Bulletin #9, take note that you may need to make adjustments to this inventory as the FS/ EAP Warden team now includes Searchers.

The importance of such apparel and its potential positive effect during an emergency is always stressed at the Warden training. Having an ample supply of this apparel available at the meeting will serve to not only reaffirm that importance but will serve as a means of saying thank you and welcome to the TEAM.
