## NEW INFORMATION PERTAINING TO THE FSD ON SITE EXAMINATION

DSSI would like to notify you about a change regarding the FSD On Site Examination for Office Buildings. We have been notified by the FDNY that as of Fall 2011 candidates who are taking the FSD On Site Exam will need to be proficient in additional information that they could possibly be tested on.

The FSD On Site Exam may include questions pertaining to the following topics:

- The Duties and Responsibilities of the Fire Safety Director
- **The Duties and Responsibilities of the Impairment Coordinator**
- Knowledge of the Building's Fire Safety Plan
- Operation of the Building's Fire Command Center
- **Phase 1 and Phase 2 Elevator Operation (Firefighter Service)**
- Effective Training for Floor Wardens
- **Effective Training for Brigade Members**
- **Company Certificates**
- **Commercial Cooking Systems**
- **Hot Works Operations**
- **Flame- Resistant Decorations**
- **Types of Fire Extinguishers**
- **Smoke Detectors**
- **Fire Department Permits**
- **Requirements for the Installation, Inspection, and Maintenance of Fire Protection Equipment**

If the Fire Safety Director Course that you completed did not cover these topics, the FDNY strongly recommends that you take the Fire Safety Director Continuing Education Course on Building Operation, Maintenance and Recordkeeping.
